

## PASTOR'S NOTE

Dear Parish Family,

We find ourselves on the first weekend of a New Year—a beautiful and grace-filled moment to pause, reflect, and look ahead with hope. The New Year invites us to plan wisely, to set our hearts on what truly matters, and to learn from the blessings and challenges of the year gone by. Whatever the past year held for you—joys or struggles—let us entrust this New Year to the Lord and ask that it may be a year of growth, peace, and abundant blessings for you and your families.

I would like to express my heartfelt gratitude to all who participated in the First Friday devotion on the 2nd. It was encouraging to see many of you come for the newly added evening Mass and to spend time with the Lord in Eucharistic Adoration. Your presence and devotion are signs of a living and prayerful parish. May the Sacred Heart of Jesus bless you for taking time to adore Him and seek His grace.

I also wish to share a personal word. By God's grace, I reached home safely after a long journey of nearly 26 hours. Thank you sincerely for your prayers during my travel—they truly sustained me. 


## Women's Ministry
