





Dear Parish Family,

As we celebrate this Third Sunday of Advent—Gaudete Sunday, the Sunday of rejoicing—my heart is filled with gratitude for the many signs of grace unfolding in our parish community. Today's Gospel (Matthew 11:2-11) invites us to reflect on John the Baptist's question to Jesus: "Are you the one who is to come?" Even as John waits in uncertainty, Jesus responds with signs of new life and hope. Advent calls us to look for these same signs of God's presence among us as we prepare for Christmas.

On the 11th, we held our Ministry Heads Meeting, and I want to express my sincere thanks to all who participated. The conversations were thoughtful, the planning was collaborative, and the enthusiasm for serving our parish was truly uplifting. Your dedication ensures that our ministries continue to be vibrant and life-giving.

On Saturday the 13th, we gathered for our Parish Penance Service. I am grateful to the priests who joined us to hear confessions and to all who came seeking God's mercy. On Tuesday the 16th, I will be visiting our homebound parishioners and offering the Sacrament of Reconciliation. These dear members remain an important part of our parish family, even if they cannot be physically present with us. Please keep them in your prayers, and may our visits remind them of the love and unity we share in Christ.

As we light the rose candle today, may its gentle glow remind us that the Lord is near. Let us continue preparing our hearts for the joy of Christmas with hope, faith, and renewed commitment to the Gospel.
